Year 6

Learners model the school's LT responsible use agreements, showing understanding by promoting safety, security, responsibility and respect when using digital tools and participating in digital environments through personal action and peer and community mentoring.

Learners follow and assist others in applying protocols and practices to demonstrate responsible use of learning technologies in the school.

Year 6

Learners reflect on, analyses and evaluates the use of learning technologies and its broad impact on lifestyles, commerce, environmental and human progress.

Learners describe how they select and use technology resources to pursue their personal and academic learning projects outside of the classroom.

Year 6

Learners model attributes of a good digital citizen who demonstrates that they are responsible and respectful in the online world and take action to create a safe and comfortable environment.

Academic Honesty

Year 6

Learners independently recognises the importance of acknowledging the owner(s)/creator(s) of digital work and establishes sound practices for acknowledging them.

Learners research, discuss, and apply safe, responsible, and legal use of technology (e.g., privacy, security, copyright, file sharing, accessibility, plagiarism). Use technology resources to convey the relevance of these issues to other students and the public at large.
